



## What is Travel Soccer?

- Higher Level of Play
  - Play against teams in other clubs
  - Play in leagues that are only for travel teams
- Higher Commitment Level
  - Not just for fun & fitness
  - Players need a desire to improve their game and play at a higher level
  - The commitment is for fall AND spring season
- Higher Cost
- Travel Outside of the BRYC Area for Games

# What are the Travel Options at BRYC?

#### **Elite Bridge Team**

- Coaches: Volunteer coaches
- **Practices:** 2 local practices per week
- Seasons: fall and spring; most travel teams play a winter league as well.
- Cost: \$655 (for fall & spring season)
- League: NCSL
- Game Locations:
  - Half of games on local fields
  - Half of games are away (could be Alexandria, Arlington, DC, Winchester, or fields in Maryland)

#### Features:

- Tryouts: Players are selected through open tryouts.
- Maintains the community feel of the team.
- Players are chosen for the team and may stay with the team and the coach.

#### **Elite Pool**

- Coaches: Paid coaches
- **Practices:** 2-3 local practices per week
- **Seasons:** 10 month program
- Cost: Determined by level of play and age group
- League: NCSL, ECNL RL, ECNL
- Game Locations:
  - NCSL Half of games are home/local fields. Half of games are away (could be MD, Winchester)
  - o ECNL-65% local
  - ECNL Regional League-75% local
- Features:
  - Tryouts: Players are selected through an open tryout process
  - Players train in a pool (all the players at that age group). They are separated by skill level for games.

# **Responsibilities of a Bridge Travel Coach:**

#### Process:

- Complete the Application
- VYSA coach license You need to have your VYSA license for the age group you are coaching. You don't have to have it when you apply to coach a bridge team, but you need to obtain it within a year.
- Annual Safe Sport training and background checks

#### Choose your players:

- Usually a team or an All Star team goes to travel, so you have a core group of players who want to move up together.
- You may hold open tryouts for other players to join you.
- **Choose a manager** The manager is usually parent of one of the players. They are rostered to the team. They must also do annual Safe Sport training and background check. They work with the Club Representative to make sure the team is set up in the VYSA database and the league database. They organize all aspects of the team, or arrange other parents to handle certain aspects (uniforms, snacks, game communication with opponents, team activities).
- Practices Set practice schedule.
- Tournaments Choose tournaments that your team will participate in.

# What is the Path to a Bridge Team?

### **How to Apply & Timeframe:**

### Fall/Winter of U8 Season -

- 1. Complete application (coaching background, team vision, team philosophy)
- 2. Submit to Committee for review. If approved...

#### **Spring of U8 Season –**

- Determine your core players
- April set up your tryout, have players register for tryout
- May choose your team. Submit list of players to Elite registrar. She sends invitations to the players.

#### **Summer Prior to U9 Season –**

- Uniforms
- Manager
- Team set up (VYSA, NCSL)

#### What is the Path to an Elite Team?

- Players register for tryouts on the Elite website.
  - Elite staff evaluate players and send invitations.
  - Players are trained as an age group.
  - Players are separated by skill level and assigned to a team.
- Coaches may request to coach with Elite, but Elite hires their own staff.
  - Coaches follow Elite curriculum.
  - Coaches are assigned the teams they will coach and the level (head coach, assistant coach).
  - Coaches may/may not work with the same team through the season. They
    may be moved as needed.
